## Announcing the Impact on our Group due to Typhoon Rai, which hit the southern part of the Philippines

We are here to announce the impact on YAMASHIN CEBU FILTER MANUFACTURING CORP. (hereinafter Cebu Plant) due to the Typhoon Rai ("No. 22" in Japanese) which hit the Philippines on Thursday, December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021 as follows.

1. Operation of Cebu Plant

Regarding inventories and fixed assets in the Cebu Plant, although the roof was damaged, the damage was minor and there was no impact on the operation.

In addition, for Mactan Island, where it is located, power supply has been stopped; however, it is expected to be restored on Monday, December 27<sup>th</sup>.

The operation has been suspended since Thursday, December 16<sup>th</sup> and will be suspended until Sunday, December 26<sup>th</sup> due to Christmas and New Year holidays which were advanced than initially planned. We are preparing to resume its operation on Monday, December 27<sup>th</sup>.

We also will support during this period until the Cebu Plant resumes its full-scale operation by carrying out alternative production at our Saga Plant and the other group operation sites.

2. Employees impacted

We have confirmed the safety of all Japanese expatriates. Approximately 90% of the local staff has confirmed their safety. We have received one report that one of them has been impacted. We will continue to confirm the safety of all the local staff.

3. Impact on business performance

At this point, we determine that the impact of this typhoon on consolidated business performance will be minor. In coming times, we will promptly notify if it becomes clear that it will have a significant impact on our consolidated business performance.
